Located in Dunkirk, northern France, and designed and assembled by the company's battery affiliate company Saft, the facility is made up of 27 containers of 2.5 MWh and boasts a power capacity of 61 MW and a total storage capacity of 61 megawatt hours (MWh).

The Saudi Power Procurement Company (SPPC) has begun qualifying bidders for an enormous undertaking of four grid-scale battery projects totaling 8 GWh of storage capacity across the Kingdom.

A second installation phase has been completed at TotalEnergies' battery energy storage facility in Dunkirk, northern France, bringing its output and capacity to 61MW / 61MWh. The battery energy storage system (BESS) was already France's biggest system of its type -- at 25MW / 25MWh -- when it was inaugurated in January 2021.
