

How will sanctions affect Cuba's electric power system?

The real impact of the sanctions on the island's Electric Power System cannot be minimized. The damage to this sector, between March 2023 and February of this year, amounted to 388,239,830 dollars, according to official estimates from Cuba.

Why is the Cuban electric power system losing its operations?

The so-called thermal generation is the basis of the Cuban Electric Power System, but it suffers from the handicap of an aging and overexploited infrastructure. In addition, it has been losing part of its operations, following the withdrawal of the Mariel, Nuevititas units and the historic Tallapiedra plant in Havana.

What does Cuba's President say about the energy crisis?

Cuba's President Miguel Díaz-Canel said Friday, " [W]e are devoting absolute priority to addressing and solving this highly sensitive energy contingency for the nation. There will be no rest until it is restored."

How much money did Cuba spend on fuel in 2022?

If in 2019 Cuba spent between 150 and 170 million dollars to buy fuel, in 2022 it was 1.7 billion, a figure that has continued to grow since then. This has happened, moreover, at a time when the island's income has fallen significantly in the midst of the deep economic and financial crisis it is experiencing.

How much fuel does Cuba consume a year?

This increases the damage to the generating plants and, therefore, the unsatisfied demand for parts and maintenance. Of the eight million tons of fuel that Cuba consumes, some five million depend on purchases on the international market, according to De La O Levy.
