

Does Israel use natural gas?

Since 2009, significant use of natural gas has begun following the discovery of natural gas reserves west of Haifa in the country's north. In 2021, Israel produced over 43 percent of its primary energy from natural gas. This energy source constituted the most common one in the country that year, followed by crude oil.

What are the major energy projects in Israel?

Two major energy projects in Israel are: (1) the construction of a 600-900MW gas-fired combined cycle Sorek power plant that is currently in the review process of the pre-qualification stage, and (2) the privatization of Israel's largest power station, a 1693MW gas-fired Eshkol power plant.

Does Israel have enough solar power?

Israel has ample solar power potential, but in 2022, it produced only 10.1% of its electricity from renewable sources, falling short of previously stated targets.

Does Israel import natural gas from Egypt?

Historically, Israel has imported natural gas through the Arish-Ashkelon pipeline from Egypt. Egypt is the second-largest natural gas producer in North Africa. In 2005 Egypt signed a 2.5 billion-dollar deal to supply Israel with 57 billion cubic feet of gas per year for fifteen years.
