After two years of decline, the Libyan electricity supply meter market increased by 204% to \$298K in 2023. Overall, consumption, however, saw a mild contraction. As a result, consumption reached the peak level of \$3.4M. From 2014 to 2023, the growth of the market failed to regain momentum.
