

Does Myanmar have solar energy?

Myanmar has plenty of sunshine and therefore, solar energy can be available throughout the country, especially in the central dry zone areas. The feasibility of developing solar energy was first looked at by the Ministry of Electricity and Energy in 2000. Solar energy can be produced in maximum amounts in April and minimum amounts in August.

Is solar energy gaining traction in Myanmar?

Solar energy is just beginning to gain some traction in Myanmar, a country that has been gradually opening up its economy and society to the world since 2011.

Which energy sources are used in Myanmar?

Biomass consumption increased between 2000 and 2016 at an average rate of 1.6 percent per year. Non-renewable energy which includes coal, natural gas and petroleum are the key sources for energy in Myanmar. Energy from non-renewable energy had increased relatively from 2014 to 2016.

What are Myanmar's energy goals?

Myanmar's government has set modest goals of renewable energy resources generating 8% of national output by 2021 and 12% by 2025, as well as universal electrification by 2030. In addition, a total of 68 townships and 5,191 villages had received 24x7 access to electricity services between 2016 and 2019, according to state media. Figure 9.

How much electricity does Myanmar need?

According to the Ministry of Electricity and Energy, by 2030 hydropower will be able to respond to 38 percent of the total energy demand, domestic natural gas 20 percent, domestic coal four percent and other renewable energy sources nine percent. Therefore, Myanmar still needs 29 percent of total electricity supply for the whole country (See Figure
