

When did solar thermal energy become a key energy source in Argentina?

Solar thermal energy in Argentina was already considered a potential key energy source in 1975, when a national R&D program for the development of solar energy and other renewables was launched, leading to numerous research programs (see next section) and the elaboration of norms and certification criteria for ST collectors .

The Indian Cabinet on Thursday, February 29, gave its nod to a comprehensive solar subsidy scheme aimed at facilitating the installation of solar rooftops for one crore individual households. The scheme, named "PM-Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana," was initially launched by Prime Minister Modi on February 13, 2024.

The latter promises up to 300 units of free electricity per month for consumers who install rooftop solar. As per the new scheme, houses with solar plants up to 3 KW will now get up to Rs 78,000 subsidy as compared to the Rs 43,764 of the earlier scheme. The scheme's target group is low- and middle-income households.

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
