Question about the breakers, can I parallel breakers? Example, using two 50 amp breakers in parallel to get 100 amp breaking capacity. I have been looking at potential power draw, and if I do the math $3000W @ 24V$ Nominal would require a 125 amp power draw, and if I wanted to do 6000w it would be 250 amp power draw.
