

What is the fastest growing sector of Ukraine's energy production?

In early 2022, when the Russian army launched its full-scale invasion, renewable electricity generation was the fastest-growing sector of Ukraine's energy production. In 2021, Ukrainian producers generated 12.8 TWh of renewable electricity which accounted for 8.1 percent of the country's total generation.

How much money has URC24 contributed to Ukraine's energy sector?

The Group has so far been able to mobilize more than USD 5 billion in support of Ukraine's energy sector, including more than USD 1 billion committed since URC24 in June as a reaction to the intensified Russian attacks.

Is the Ukraine energy support fund restoring domestic generation capacity?

While the Ukraine Energy Support Fund is currently restoring and installing 2 GW of domestic generation capacity ahead of winter, a significant gap to cover the restoration needs still remains. We therefore encourage the international community to continue contributions.

How has Russia impacted Ukraine's energy infrastructure?

The two previous winters of the war were already challenging, but Russia has now intensified its attacks on Ukraine's energy infrastructure, with at least 11 major missile and drone strikes since March. About half of Ukraine's generating capacity was knocked out and distribution networks were also damaged.

Is Ukraine a member of the European Energy Community?

In 2011, Ukraine joined the European Energy Community, however there has been slow progress on implementing European energy regulations. Ukraine extracts about 20 billion cubic meters of fossil gas each year, and since 2022 this has almost met demand.

How will the energy transition affect Ukraine's energy policy?

Decisions made in Brussels on the exact contours of the energy transition will have a major influence on energy policy decisions made in Ukraine. The country has significant potential to produce decarbonized and renewable electricity. On February 24, 2022, dozens of Ukrainian technicians and engineers kept a late watch.

Ukraine extracts about 20 billion cubic meters of fossil gas each year, and since 2022 this has almost met demand. [14] Ukraine has been estimated to possess natural gas reserves of over 670 billion cubic meters (in 2022), [15] and gas is an important part of energy in Ukraine. In 2021, Ukraine produced 19.8 billion cubic meters (bcm or Gm 3) of natural gas.
