

M-Kopa (M for mobile, kopa is Swahili for borrow, stylized as M-KOPA) [1] is a UK-headquartered emerging market fintech platform that provides affordable smartphones and digital financial services. [2] [3] M-Kopa was launched commercially in 2012 and is headquartered in London. The company is currently operating in Kenya, Nigeria, Ghana, Uganda and South Africa.

The Pay As You Go solar power company in East Africa had sales of \$71 million in 2019. It wished to grow to \$300 million by 2025. M-KOPA, founded by three entrepreneurs in 2011, had grown nicely in Kenya and Uganda to reach nearly 750,000 households with an innovative direct sales force model.

M-KOPA, part of LGT Venture Philanthropy's social impact portfolio, is a for-profit social enterprise that facilitates access to solar-powered home lighting and phone charging systems for off-grid households.

M-KOPA is the market leader in developing and selling "solar home systems" (SHSs) (i.e. off-grid electricity) to rural consumers in East Africa on favorable credit terms. Once the SHS has been paid for it can be used as collateral for further credit sales from M-KOPA, for example water tanks, fuel-efficient cook stoves and other productive ...

M-Kopa. M-Kopa primarily operates in Kenya (80% of 300,000-customer base) off the M-Pesa platform. The company provides solar kits to low income households on credit. The customer pays a \$35 upfront fee, and agrees to make a daily payment of \$0.35, taking on a loan of around \$165.
